

## Terms and Conditions for registering as a RecoRa Student

Registering as a Student of the RecoRa Institute entitles you to the following restricted rights relating to the materials provided to you as part of the RecoRa Programme. By registering as a student and/or attending any learning event provided by the RecoRa Institute you are agreeing to be bound by the following commits terms:

Restricted Rights:

- You are entitled to use these materials to inform any policy or strategy document developed by your organisation subject to the requirement that the source of these materials are acknowledged and reference as being authored by Meah, Y and Mellis C on behalf of the RecoRa Institute; and further that readers are directed to the report: Recognising and Responding to Radicalisation .... - You are entitled to use these materials in any briefing - defined as a session lasting no more than 1 hour - for the purpose of illustrating and providing instruction on any policy, procedure or practice which has been developed by your employing organisation utilising wholly or in part the materials developed by the RecoRa Institute subject to the requirement to acknowledge the source of these materials as described in the clause above
- You are entitled to use these materials for the purpose of training or instructing others as part of the process of embedding expertise within your employing organisation on condition that your employing organisation maintains a license to deliver such learning events from the RecoRa Institute and employs at least one member of its workforce who has been assessed as a graduate of the RecoRa Programme – and who maintains membership of the RecoRa Graduate Forum.

As a student of the RecoRa Programme you are agreeing to the following additional terms and conditions. Terms:

This does not exclude your right to distribute or amend the materials for the purposes specified in any of the above clauses and which you have, through your employing organisation, been granted restricted rights.

Not to use any or part of the materials in any form of training other than within an event which you have been assigned to deliver by your employing organisation or by the RecoRa Institute or an agent licensed by the RecoRa Institute or its UK Partner [The Government Office for the West Midlands] to deliver learning events using the materials designed by the Institute or any materials designed by one of its partner organisations as part of the RecoRa Programme.
